Board Minutes January 15, 2024 The Board of Supervisors met at 9:30am January 15, 2024 with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited, and the meeting was called to or-

Barb Schroeder, Conservation Director, and members of the Conservation Board, met with the Board to give an annual report and review the FY25 budget.

Moved by Faldet and seconded by Vermace to open the public hearing on the proposed vacation of right-of-way in the village of Bluffton. Public asked a few questions, and no additional comments were received. Moved by Vick and seconded by Faldet to close the public hearing. Motion carried unanimously. Moved by Vick and seconded by Kelsay to adopt resolution 24-31, authorizing the vacation of the right-of-way as proposed. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote. Quit Claim deed will be issued to Mark and Edith Dawley and recorded in the County Recorder's office.
