Board Minutes May 5, 2025 The Board of Supervisors met at 9:30am May 5, 2025 with Kelsav Vick, Langreck, Vermace, and Faldet present. The Pledge of Alle-giance to the Flag was recited, and the meeting was called to order. Jon Vagts and Chris Wuebker, Opioid Taskforce, met with the Board to introduce Jen Pearson, UCS Healthcare, and give an overview of their Opioid Treatment programs. The Taskforce is recommending an expenditure of \$19,000 from Opioid Settlement funds to UCS Healthcare to help them continue their programs here in Winneshiek County. Moved by Kelsay and seconded by Faldet to approve the request. Motion carried unanimously. Michael Kueny, County Engineer, met with the Board to review road projects and present his FY25 DOT budget amendment. Moved by Faldet and seconded by Kelsay to approve the budget amendment as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Vick and seconded by Faldet to approve the hire of John Bodensteiner for the Bridge Crew and Alex Kuennen for the Operator Il positions. Motion carried unanimously

Moved by Vermace and seconded by Kelsay to approve the road clo-sure request for a portion of County Rd B32 on July 4th for the Festina Community. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Vick and seconded by Faldet to adopt resolution 25-35, setting the public hearing on the FY25 budget amendment for 9:30am on May 27th. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote. Public notice will be published as required

Moved by Vermace and seconded by Faldet to renew the contract with Employee and Family Resources

Inc for the Employee Assistance Motion carried unaniprogram. mously.

Moved by Vermace and seconded by Faldet to sign the letter of support for the City of Decorah's ap-plication to the Iowa Thriving Communities program. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Vick and seconded by Kelsay to approve the consent agenda which includes the minutes of the last meeting and to accept and file the monthly reports of the VA Commission and the County Recorder. Motion carried unani-

mously. Andy Van Der Maaten, County Attorney, met with the Board to discuss county issues.
