Board Minutes June 30, 2025 The Board of Supervisors met at 9:30am June 30, 2025 with Kelsay, Vick, Langreck, Vermace, and Faldet present. The Pledge of Alle-giance to the Flag was recited, and the meeting was called to order.

Michael Kueny, County Engineer, met with the Board to give road updates.

Moved by Vick and seconded by Faldet to approve the consent agenda which includes the minutes of the last meeting, the claims filed with the Board, and to accept and file the quarterly report of the County Auditor. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Vick and seconded by Kelsay to adopt resolution 25-45, appropriating FY26 funds to the various departments and officers at 100% of the budgeted amount except for Public Health at \$350,000. Moved by Faldet and seconded by Kelsay to adopt resolution 25-46, reappropriating \$5,000 from Rural Waste to Recycling. Motion car-ried unanimously by roll call vote. Complete resolution is on file in the County Auditor's office. Andy Van Der Maaten, County Attorney, met with the Board to dis-

cuss county issues. Moved by Faldet and seconded by Vick to enter closed session to ex-amine the bid and determine possible next steps on the sale of the former HHS property. Closed session is authorized under IAC 21.5(1)(j)

Motion carried unanimously and the closed session was held. Moved by Faldet and seconded by Kelsay to re-enter open session. Motion carried unanimously. Moved by Kel-say and seconded by Faldet to not take any action to schedule a public hearing on the sale of the property at this time. Motion carried with Kelsay, Langreck, Vermace. and Faldet voting aye; and Vick voting nay.

Moved by Faldet and seconded by Vick to adjourn to 9:30am Monday, July 7, 2025. Motion carried unanimously ATTEST
