ject increased approximately \$ 3,000. The bid for the project was more than the engineers estimate and \$ 3,000 is our projected cost increase. Greg Barta reported that the trees at Oak Hill Cemetery were removed and the stumps ground. He is placing dirt where needed. Trees also removed on E. Main Street with the property owner sharing the cost of removal with the city. The DNR was in Fort Atkinson on Monday to inspect the wastewater treatment facility. Greg reported all was satisfactory. He stated he is still working with the water Chlorine Residual to get it within the DNR requirements. Water loss due to water leaks was discussed, this will be monitored to make sure all have been repaired. Motion by P. Schmitt, second by Glass to approve the building permit for Marvin Krivachek.
