ty, Iowa, intends to fill the vacancy created by the pending retirement of Winneshiek County Treasurer Brenda Kreitzer, by appointment pursuant to Chapter 69 of the Iowa Code. Notice is given that the electors of Winneshiek County have a right to file a petition requiring that the vacancy be filled by special election. If within 14 days after publication of this Notice or within 14 days after the appointment is made, whichever is later, a petition is filed with the County Auditor requesting a special election to fill the vacancy, the appointment will be deemed temporary, and a special election shall be called as provided in Iowa Code Section 69.14A(2)(b).
