BOARD MINUTES NOVEMBER 13 AND 14, 2023 The Board of Supervisors met at

9:30am November 13, 2023 with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited, and the meeting was called to order.

Ben Stevens and Steve Slessor. WinnMed financial and executive officers, met with the Board to present a report on the WinnMed financial statements at the end of FY23. Doug Groux, County Sanitarian, met with the Board to review his FY25 budget.

Jon Lubke, IT and GIS Director. met with the Board to discuss the process for putting together the Systems Administrator job description. Kelsav and Vermace will work with Lubke on this project.

Jayne Schultz, County Recorder, met with the Board to review her FY25 budget.

Tony Phillips, Planning, Zoning, and Flood Plain Administrator; met with the Board to discuss his FY25 budget and give an update on the NFIP timeline.

Andy Van Der Maaten, County Attorney, met with the Board to discuss county issues.

Moved by Faldet and seconded by Vick to open the public hearing on the vacation of a portion of Wren Valley Rd. Motion carried unanimously.
