The Board of Supervisors met at 9:30am November 20, 2023 with all members present (Faldet electronically.) The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited, and the meeting was called to order.

The Board of Supervisors, ex-officio Board of County Canvassers for Winneshiek County, canvassed the Second Tier results for the Decorah CSD Election held on Tuesday November 7, 2023. Moved by Vick and seconded by Vermace to certify the canvass summary and abstracts of votes, and declare Brian Petersburg, Carole Sand, and Aaron Zander duly elected to the position of Decorah CSD Board of Directors. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Vermace and seconded by Vick to approve the tax abatement for the City of Calmar for parcel 142645601200 for the current and past due taxes in the amount of \$1155. Motion carried unanimously.

\$571,000 (GENERAL OBLIGATION)

The Board of Supervisors of Winneshiek County, lowa, will meet on December 11, 2023, at 9:25 o'clock a.m., at the Courthouse Annex, Decorah, Iowa, for the purpose of instituting proceedings and taking action to enter into a loan and disbursement agreement (the "Agreement") and to borrow money thereunder in a principal amount not to exceed \$571,000 for the purpose of paying the cost, to that extent, of planning, designing and constructing improvements and extensions to works and facilities useful for the collection, treatment, and disposal of sewage and industrial waste in a

sanitary manner in the County.
The Agreement is proposed to be entered into pursuant to authority contained in Section 331.402 of the Code of Iowa and will constitute a

general obligation of the County. At that time and place, oral or written objections may be filed or made to the proposal to enter into the Loan Agreement. After receiving objections, the County may determine to enter into the Loan Agreement, in which case, the decision will be final unless appealed to the District Court within fifteen (15)

days thereafter.
