Steinlage made a motion to authorize the district's administration to submit a request to the School Budget Review Committee for a modified supplemental amount of \$95,332 for students who open-enrolled out this year and were not on the prior year's student count. Seconded by Manderfield. Carried unanimously.

Hageman made a motion to authorize the district's administration to submit a request to the School Budget Review Committee for a

modified supplemental amount of \$7,082 for students who are beyond 5 years of LEP instruction. Seconded by Manderfield. Carried unanimously.

Brown took nominations for school board president. Steinlage motioned to nominate Don Blazek as president and Manderfield seconded. Brown took a roll call vote for Blazek to be school board president. Yeas - Stika, Hageman, Manderfield and Steinlage. Blazek withheld. Blazek was on zoom so he will take the oath at the Jannary meeting. Nominations closed. Carried unanimously.

ried unanimously. Brown took nominations for school board vice president. Hageman motioned to nominate Katie Stika as vice president and Steinlage seconded that motion. Roll call vote was taken. Yeas - Jamie Hageman, Don Manderfield and Jody Steinlage. Blazek was on zoom. Stika withheld. Nominations closed. Carried unanimously. Katie Stika took the oath of office as vice president of the school board. Janice Brown took the oath of office as business manager and board secretary.

Moved by Hageman and seconded by Manderfield to approve Carrie Weber with Ahlers and Cooney, PC as the official attorney for Turkey Valley Community School District. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Steinlage and seconded by Hageman to approve The Calmar Courier as the official newspaper of the district. Carried unanimously. Moved by Steinlage and second-

Moved by Steinlage and seconded by Manderfield to approve the school board committee assignments as: 1) Negotiations A) Certified - Blazek, Hageman & Stika B) Non-Certified - Manderfield & Steinlage; 2) Facilities - Blazek & Hageman; 3) Transportation - Steinlage & Stika; 4) Audit/Budget - Manderfield & Stika. Carried unanimously.

The board will discuss the superintendent search committee during the closed session.

Mrs. Hoy shared that the kindergarten through 5th grade students are responding well to the LETRS Training. Also the high school students gathered 420 pounds of food/ supplies and \$320.00 to donate to the Northeast Iowa Food Bank in Calmar. Great job!

Hageman and Manderfield attended the school board convention. Both said that it was a great meeting and if possible, they would like to have all board members, and the new superintendent, attend next year. The board thought it would be valuable to have a speaker come to Turkey Valley. They will discuss that with the new superintendent for next year.
