Turkey Valley Community School Minutes 12.02.2024

The Turkey Valley School Board met in a regular session on Monday, December 9, 2024. The meeting was held in the Conference Room at Turkey Valley School, Jackson Junction, IA. Katie Stika called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. The following Board Directors answered roll call: Katie Stika, Jamie Hageman, Don Manderfield and Jody Steinlage. Don Blazek Jr. joined via zoom.

Moved by Manderfield and seconded by Hageman to approve the agenda as presented. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Hageman and seconded by Steinlage to approve the board minutes for November 11, 2024, regular meeting. Appointments: none; Resignations: none

Moved by Hageman and seconded by Manderfield to approve the financial reports and bills. General Fund \$54,897.62 Clearing \$34,863.71, Hot Lunch \$14,544.65, Capital \$3,040.00 PPEL \$33,463.33. Carried unanimously.

A senior career student introduced herself and stayed for the meeting.

Manderfield made a motion to authorize the district's administration to submit a request to the School Budget Review Committee for a modified supplemental amount of \$4,774 due to an increase of certified enrollment from the prior year. Seconded by Steinlage. Carried unanimously.

Steinlage made a motion to authorize the district's administration to submit a request to the School Budget Review Committee for a modified supplemental amount of \$95,332 for students who open-enrolled out this year and were not on the prior year's student count. Seconded by Manderfield. Carried unanimously.

Hageman made a motion to authorize the district's administration to submit a request to the School Budget Review Committee for a modified supplemental amount of \$7,082 for students who are beyond 5 years of LEP instruction.

Seconded by Manderfield. Carried unanimously.

Brown took nominations for school board president. Steinlage motioned to nominate Don Blazek as president and Manderfield seconded. Brown took a roll call vote for Blazek to be school board president. Yeas - Stika, Hageman, Manderfield and Steinlage. Blazek withheld. Blazek was on zoom so he will take the oath at the January meeting. Nominations closed. Carried unanimously.

Brown took nominations for school board vice president. Hageman motioned to nominate Katie Stika as vice president and Steinlage seconded that motion. Roll call vote was taken. Yeas - Jamie Hageman, Don Manderfield and Jody Steinlage. Blazek was on zoom. Stika withheld. Nominations closed. Carried unanimously. Katie Stika took the oath of office as vice president of the school board. Janice Brown took the oath of office as business manager and board secretary.

Moved by Hageman and seconded by Manderfield to approve Carrie Weber with Ahlers and Cooney, PC as the official attorney for Turkey Valley Community School District. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Hageman to approve The Calmar Courier as the official newspaper of the district. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Steinlage and seconded by Hageman to approve the school board committee assignments as: 1) Negotiations A) Certified - Blazek, Hageman & Stika B) Non-Certified - Manderfield & Steinlage; 2) Facilities - Blazek & Hageman; 3) Transportation - Steinlage & Stika; 4) Audit/Budget - Manderfield & Stika. Carried unanimously.

The board will discuss the superintendent search committee during the closed session.

Mrs. Hoy shared that the kindergarten through 5th grade students are responding well to the LETRS Training. Also the high school students gathered 420 pounds of food/ supplies and \$320.00 to donate to the Northeast Iowa Food Bank in

Calmar. Great job!

Hageman and Manderfield attended the school board convention. Both said that it was a great meeting and if possible, they would like to have all board members, and the new superintendent, attend next year. The board thought it would be valuable to have a speaker come to Turkey Valley. They will discuss that with the new superintendent for next year.

Thank you to Melvin Bodensteiner and the Knights of Columbus for their generous donation of \$800.00 to special needs students/supplies. Thank you for your support!

The board prepared to go into closed session. All guests left the conference room. Stika asked for a roll call. The following board members were present: Katie Stika, Jamie Hageman, Don Manderfield, and Jody Steinlage. Don Blazek joined via zoom. Joan Busta also attended the closed meeting.

Stika motioned Per Iowa Code Chapter 21.5(i) a school board may enter closed session "to evaluate the professional competency of an individual whose appointment, hiring, performance, or discharge is being considered when closed session is necessary to prevent needless and irreparable injury to that individual's reputation and that individual requests a closed session".

Seconded by Manderfield to go into closed session at 6:30 PM. Carried unanimously. The board discussed the superintendent search committee. Moved by Stika and seconded by Manderfield to come out of the closed session at 7:00 PM. Carried unanimously. Moved by Steinlage and seconded by Manderfield to adjourn at 7:00 PM.

Moved by Hageman and seconded by Steinlage to table the superintendent search committee item. Carried unanimously.

The next regular school board meeting will be held on Monday January 13, 2025@ 5:00 PM. Moved by Manderfield and seconded by Hageman to adjourn at 7:00 PM. Carried unanimously.
