BOARD MINUTES MONDAY FEBRUARY 6, 2023

The Board of Supervisors met at 9:30am February 6, 2023 with Vick, Kelsay, Langreck, Vermace, and Faldet present.

Lee Bjerke, County Engineer, met with the Board to discuss road matters.

Moved by Vick and seconded by Faldet to award the bid for Bridge 317 to the low bidder K Construction for \$143,572. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Vick and seconded by Vermace to approve the consent agenda which includes the minutes of the last meeting and to accept and file the monthly report of the County Recorder and the quarterly report of the County Sheriff. Motion carried unanimously.

Steve Johnson and Ashley Christensen, Historic Preservation Commission, met with the Board to present the annual CLG report for their commission and to report on other projects. Moved by Vermace and seconded by Kelsay to approve the annual CLG report. Motion carried unanimously.

Corey Meyer, Roadside Manager, met with the Board to give a program update. Moved by Vick and seconded by Kelsay to terminate the Roadside Management Program due to funding concerns, ef-

fective immediately. Motion carried with Vick, Kelsay, and Langreck voting aye; and Vermace and Faldet voting nay.

Andy Van Der Maaten, county Attorney, met with the Board to discuss county issues. Vermace asked if there was a petition process for requesting a public hearing on a topic. Van Der Maaten said that Iowa law did not have a process for the public to compel a public hearing or public comment session, but that if it was requested the Board could act to hold one if they wished.

Moved by Vermace and seconded by Vick to approve the Exhibit C to the previously approved Court-house Tower Easement. Motion carried unanimously.

The Board reviewed several budget items including additions and changes to staffing requested by departments, implementation options for the Salary Survey, and other miscellaneous topics.

Moved by Kelsay and seconded by Faldet to adjourn to 9:30am Monday, February 13, 2023. Motion carried unanimously.

The Turkey Valley School Board met in a regular session on Monday, February 13, 2023. The meeting was held in the Elementary Meeting Room at Turkey Valley School, Jackson Junction, IA. Ernie Schmitt called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM. The following Board Directors answered roll call: Leon Shatek, Katie Stika, Don Blazek Jr, Ernie Schmitt and Jody Steinlage.

Moved by Blazek and seconded by Stika to approve the agenda as presented but will move item 6C, Concession Stands Plans to the first item of old business. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Blazek and seconded by Shatek to approve the consent agenda items. Board Minutes: January 9, 2023, regular meeting; Appointments: none; Resignations: Shelby Hageman - 7&8 grade volleyball coach and Mary Watt - special education teacher. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Steinlage and seconded by Stika to approve the financial reports and bills. General Fund \$199,534.64, Hot Lunch \$13,135.90, Clearing \$40,379.73, PPEL \$3,440.83, Capital \$3,093.50 Carried unanimously. Public Forum - none
Aaron Schmidt, Turkey Valley Athletic Booster President, shared updated plans for the concession stands. The new concession stands will be built where the current stand is located.

Mr. Schmidt asked the board to approve that the current building be removed by someone other than the Boosters. The Boosters will get rid of the existing concrete though. The Boosters will install a leach field. They have researched tiling and the surrounding area for the best placement of it. The TVAB is looking for approval from the board to move forward with this project. They want to begin as soon as weather permits, ensuring that construction is complete for the 2023 football season. Moved by Blazek and seconded by Stika to approve the construction of the concession stand by the football/baseball field. Carried unanimously.

Mr. Jurrrens shared a draft of the 2023-2024 school calendar with the board. He will share it with staff and hold the public hearing in April. This was informational only.

Moved by Blazek and seconded by Shatek to approve the architect contract of \$45,000.00 with Align Architecture & Planning, PLC, Waterloo Iowa, for the Industrial Technology Shop Project. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Stika and seconded by Blazek to approve the Course Guide for 2023-2024 as presented. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Steinlage and seconded by Stika to approve the District Developed Service Delivery Plan. Carried unanimously.

Mr. Jurrrens shared with the board that the Turkey Valley Education Association submitted their intent to negotiate. No motion needed.

Moved by Blazek and seconded by Stika to approve the FFA Easter Egg Fundraiser again this year.

Carried unanimously. Moved by Blazek and seconded by Steinlage to approve preschool tuition and fees for 2023-

2024 as follows: All preschool is 4 days per week - no Wednesday preschool. 3 year olds attending half days is \$105.00 monthly. 3 year olds attending full days is \$210.00 monthly; The 4 year olds attend full days only and the cost will be no more than \$130.00 per month. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Shatek and seconded by Stika to approve an additional 1st grade teacher for 2023-2024. Class sizes deem an additional first grade teacher is needed. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Blazek and seconded by Shatek to approve the budget guarantee which we don't need to participate in this year but is available as needed. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Blazek and seconded by Steinlage to approve the first reading of board policies, series 500. Carried unanimously.

Mrs. Hoy informed the board that the FAST winter screeners are complete. Thank you to the teachers who work with our ELL students. High school mentors helping in the elementary is a great project. IBN students have an Instagram and other social media accounts which they can use to help share Turkey Valley happenings, projects and pride. Congratulations to the following for their accomplishments: band, girls and boys basketball, and girls and boys wrestling. Happening now: FFA Week, Trap Shooting fish fry, individual speech and robotics team. Thank you to Michelle Nystal again for her work on hosting speech at Turkey Valley. Thank you to St. Lucas Knights of Columbus for a \$700 donation and tickets for KofC supper.

St. Lucas Auxiliary treating staff, Lawler Lions for tickets for staff for the breakfast and thank you to Dave Ludwig Estate for their donation to the fine arts programs at Turkey Valley. So many amazing people in this community that we call Turkey Valley!

Mr. Jurrrens invited the board to attend the joint work session with The New Hampton School Board at New Hampton on Monday, March 20, 2023 @ 6:00 PM.
